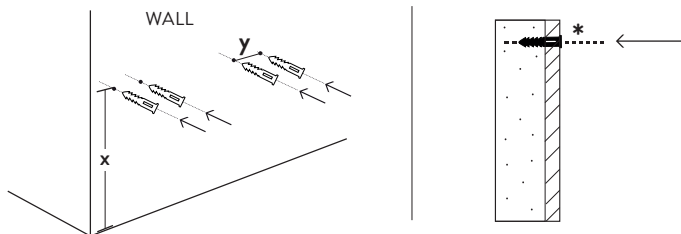
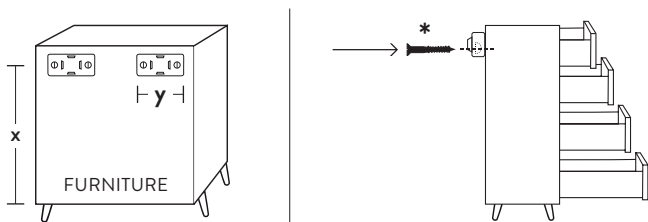
## MAKE IT SAFE!

Understand the dangers of TV and furniture tip-overs. Properly securing TVs and furniture using anti-tip devices can significantly reduce, but not eliminate the risk of tip-overs. Follow a few simple steps to protect a child from injury and death.

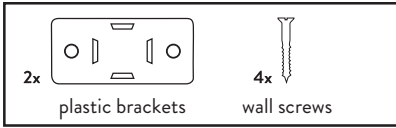
- Televisions should only be placed on furniture designed to hold a television, such as television stands or media units.
- Televisions that are not wall mounted should still be anchored to the wall.
- Mount flat-screen TVs to the wall or to furniture to prevent them from toppling over.
- CRT televisions should only be placed on furniture designed to hold a television, and should be anchored to the wall or to the TV stand.
- Remove items that might tempt children to climb, such as toys and remote controls, from the top of televisions and furniture.
- Supervise children at play, especially in unfamiliar environments. Never let them climb or hang on drawers, doors, or shelves.
- Affix anti-tip devices immediately to new furniture. Existing furniture can be affixed with inexpensive anti-tip devices which are readily available.
- Ensure the anti-tip device used complies with **ASTM standard F3096-14 Standard Performance for Tipover Restraint(s) Used with Clothing Storage Unit(s)**
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions when securing TVs and furniture.

# WALL ANCHORING INSTRUCTIONS

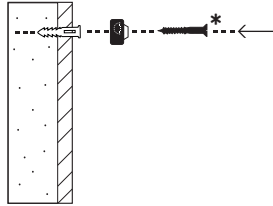
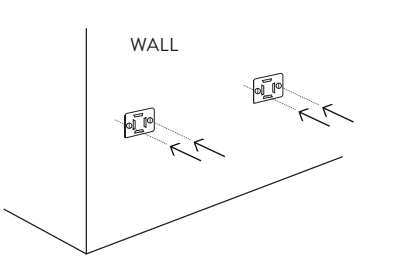
The hardware provided in this kit is designed to attach to the back of most storage units, chest of drawers, and bookcases. Properly affixing furniture to your wall will depend on the wall material; drywall, masonry, or wood will require the appropriate hardware. This kit includes anchors that are best suited for a drywall application. Please consult your local hardware store to ensure you are using the correct hardware for your wall type.



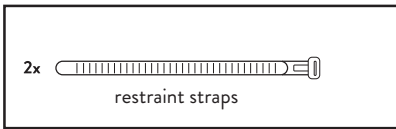

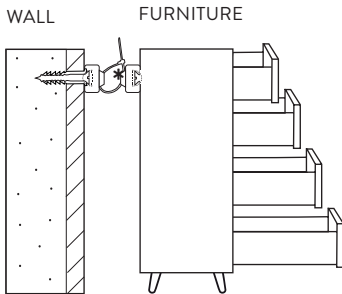
